Topic 1:

- School council email address in now up and running and has been shard with every classroom/group and care areas.
- Access to the emails for the council currently through APa. No emails received yet.
- Some pupils are still setting up their own school email accounts.

Topic 2:

- Sports fixtures.

 are to follow.

Topic 3:

- Music room update.
- Message from JWi passed on. Some brass instruments are to be brought in for pupils to learn how to play.
- New storage cupboard needed to help us keep the instruments away from potential damage. APa to email BRe.

- SC responded with a positive yes. PMa suggested a sign-up sheet with your name and instrument you would like to learn. APa to discuss this with SLT.

Topic 4:

- End of year trips ideas for year 6 to 9?
- Activity based trips suggested by the SC, these included Thorpe park, Poulton's Park, Go Karting and Ice Skating. Maybe an option of one. Similar to the last year.

Topic 5:

- Access to the log ins for steam/epic games as some pupils have their own accounts and when they log out of the school's one's others then cannot get in. Passwords and account usernames have been emailed out to staff.
- Money for games. Could there be a budget set for each term so that a voucher can be purchased for each account, then games can be brought for the PC's that have been voted on (age appropriate also). Once a budget is agreed SC to run a poll/vote for the games to be purchased each month. Games suggested so far are Minecraft, Scrape Mechanic, flight simulator, Deep Rock Galactic, Trail Maker, BMG Drive.
- Waiting for finance to see if this is available. APa will continue to chase this.
- We now have 2 VR headsets that can be used for educational purposes and for games.
 Waiting for these to become available.

Topic 6:

- Afternoon clubs the SC decided would be a good idea. Suggested clubs would be Football, board games, badminton, martial arts, esports, riding/maintenance of bikes and a fitness club. APa to pass this back to MRe.
- SC raised regarding lunch club that lunch time can already be short with eating etc so afternoon clubs would be better.

Topic 7:

- Pupil voice regarding sleep and food.
- Discussion around what is preventing sleep at school. SC helped create a food and sleep survey to shared with their peers to help gain a wider pupil voice. This will be handing out in the following week and results brought back to SC in the next meeting.

AOB:

- Leavers Hoodies Yr 11 tutors are currently looking into this with costing and time frame for arrival.
- The school council will now meet twice a term.
- Further advance notice of SC meetings. All meetings are placed on tutor boards and in care areas. Pupils will be reminded at the beginning of each week when there is a meeting.
- CMa has now joined the SC due to the change in other pupil's time tables/interventions.
- House's WIFI JMs raised issues around the houses WIFI. PKe informed the SC about
 the plans for each of the house to have their own WIFI which should help increase the
 speed. This is being put in place over the coming weeks.
